I hope this letter reaches each of your families finally adjusted to the new school year. While school has only been in session for less than a week I am taking this opportunity to detail out a tentative payment schedule for our spring trip to Dallas. I understand that budgeting our money in this trying economic time is essential. I hope that the information I will provide you will allow you to make this experience for your children a little easier to manage than before.

The next deposit that will be due towards the Dallas trip is scheduled for October 16th. The deposit will be for the amount of \$150 and the checks will need to be made payable to BOHS Band. There are two fundraisers taking place over the next couple of weeks that may be applied towards your deposit. The first is the Entertainment Book fundraiser in which every student will receive \$7 per book sold. The next fundraiser starting the week of September 7th is a Cherrydale Farm brochure fundraiser. Students will receive between 30%-40% for items sold in this fundraiser. We will do our best to calculate the profit earned from both fundraisers, however due to the processing time of the brochure sale we may not be able to apply it towards this upcoming deposit, but most definitely the future deposits. With this said, please look below for a breakdown of the upcoming deposit schedule.
